Safety advice when visiting a property

Do:

- try to view the property in daylight;
- if possible, take someone with you;
- if you cannot take someone with you, leave details of where you are going, the time of the viewing and the name of the person you are meeting with a friend or relative;
- ask the person you are meeting if there will be someone else at the property when you are viewing;
- carry a personal alarm and have it in an easily accessible place;
- take your mobile phone with you leaving it on and in a safe and easily accessible place;
- use you mobile to let someone know that you have arrived at the viewing and ask them to ring you if they have not heard from you after a set time;
- if you feel something is not right at the viewing, make your excuses and leave straight away.

Don't:

• accept a lift before or after the viewing from the person you are meeting.

Safety advice when someone is visiting your property

Do:

- try to make sure someone is with you during the viewing;
- ask the person viewing your property if there is someone else coming with them and, if so, ask who it is;
- let a friend, neighbour or relative know that someone is coming to view you home and give them the name, address and telephone number of the person and also the time of the viewing;
- let the person viewing your home know that someone will be dropping in to see you during the viewing and arrange for someone to do so;
- if you feel something is not right, phone your arranged friend, neighbour or relative and ask if they can come round immediately.

Don't:

• give out any unnecessary personal details.
