- Tenant Panel members work as a critical friend to Cornwall Housing.
- Working in partnership with Cornwall Housing to improve services.
- The panel is an independent group supported by the Communication and Engagement Team



- Panel members listen to tenants and look at a range of information before deciding what areas to scrutinise.
- Panel members report their findings to tenants, Cornwall Housing Board and Cornwall Housing Tenants Forum.

Would you like to get involved?

- The panel meets once a month; however, this can be more frequent during a scrutiny exercise.
- Full training is offered, and members are supported at all times.
- The positions are voluntary, and we pay for childcare, transport and provide lunch.
