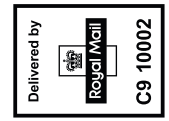

Follow our 5 steps to safety!

1. Check your smoke alarm monthly

Your home is fitted with a smoke alarm – check your alarm is working at least monthly. If there is a fault, report it to our repairs team on **0300 1234 161**

2. Keep fire doors shut at all times

You are helping to **stop** the spread of fire. An open fire door cannot prevent the spread of heat, flames or smoke!

3. Don't leave things in corridors

As this can cause an increased risk of fire, or a blockage that can restrict safe evacuation.

4. Report any faults

Our blocks of flats are regularly inspected for fire safety. This involves checking for risks, checking alarms, identifying problems and carrying out repairs. If you see any faults around your building or spot a problem with a fire door (including missing or broken self-closers), let us know on **0300 1234 161**

5. Don't make unauthorised home improvements

To ensure that you are not put at greater risk from fire by home improvements; you need to get our permission to make any alterations to your flat. This is to ensure that changes do not affect your fire safety, and the safety of your neighbours.
